## **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

To be used only in the manufacture of a product which is registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT. Read the Technical Bulletin for formulation details.

## **PRECAUTIONS**

**KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.** Strictly observe all precautions for handling and using pesticides. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Do not contaminate food, feed or water supplies. Workers using this product in an open system must wear protective clothing: safety boots/rubber boots, coveralls, impervious gloves, safety glasses/face shield and a NIOSH-approved pesticide respirator.

## **FIRST AID**

If poisoning is suspected, call a physician immediately or contact a poison control centre. Take container, label or the product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

**If swallowed**, call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

**If on skin or clothing**, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

**If inhaled**, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

**If in eyes**, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

## **TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION**

No specific antidote is available. Apply symptomatic therapy. If a large amount has been ingested, induce emesis or lavage stomach. An aqueous suspension of activated charcoal can be given to absorb remaining toxicant.

## **DISPOSAL**

Canadian manufacturers should dispose of unwanted active ingredients and containers in accordance with municipal and provincial regulations. For additional details and clean up of spills, contact the manufacturer and the provincial regulatory agency.

**STORAGE**

Store in original containers in a well-ventilated, cool, dry, and secure area out of reach of children and domestic animals. Ship and store away from food, feed, seed, fertilizer or other pesticides. Keep containers tightly closed.
