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DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a biofungicide/bactericide/herbicide which is registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*.

PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL

Severely irritating to the skin and eye. DO NOT get on skin or in eyes. Avoid breathing mist. Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, waterproof gloves, and eye goggles and shoes plus socks when handling, mixing, loading or applying, and during all clean-up and repair activities. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

The handling of lactic acid, as well as the clean-up and maintenance activities should be performed in a well ventilated area. DO NOT discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems, lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters.

FIRST AID:

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Treat symptomatically.

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STORAGE:

Store containers tightly closed, out of direct sunlight, at temperatures between 4° C and 20° C. Cooler storage temperatures are preferred.
