DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

In all applications, open container and pour Unicide B100 into the system in the areas specified below:

Paper Mills:

Unicide B100 should be used at 30-50 g per tonne of dry paper produced at least once per day

Oilfield Applications:

Use 100 ppm active ingredient based on the water content of the system until control is achieved. Maintenance dosage 10-25 ppm.

Oil Storage Tanks: Open the container and pour Unicide B100 through thief hatch.

Heat Exchangers, Cooling Towers, Condensers, Air Washers:

Pre-clean heavily fouled systems (e.g. with chlorine). Shock dosages of 100 ppm based on the water content of the system may be used until control is achieved. Maintenance dosage 15-50 ppm. Open the the container and pour Unicide B100 directly into the sump of the system at a convenient point.

FIRST AID:

If in eyes, hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If on skin or clothing, take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. If inhaled, move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. If swallowed, call a poison control centre or

doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number when seeking medical attention.

Wear goggles or a face shield, chemical-resistant gloves, long pants, a long sleeved-shirt, shoes and socks during mixing/loading, clean up and repair
