PRECAUTIONS

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL

May cause slight eye and skin irritation. Do not get this product in eyes, or on skin or clothing. Avoid breathing dust or vapours. Avoid skin contact. FIRST AID

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.
