DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

This product should not be used or compounded with any reducing or oxidizing agents (such as calcium hypochlorite, solid perchlorate or nitric acid) since mixtures may be explosive. Do not use in conjunction with soap or any anionic wetting agent. Wear goggles or face shield, rubber gloves and respirator if mist is generated. Under certain conditions, the use of protective creams may be advisable. Wash thoroughly after handling.

To be used only in the manufacture, formulating or repacking of a microbiocide product which is registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*. Formulators are responsible for their own registrations.

Wash hands and face before eating, drinking, smoking and using the toilet. Change clothing daily. Wash contaminated clothing separately from household laundry.

FIRST AID:

IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION
