The Automatic Lure Pump (ALP) fits directly into your A24 Rat & Mouse Trap and attract rats and mice by automatically extruding paste and oils without you needing to re-visit your A24 Rat & Mouse Trap for 6 months.

To increase the attractiveness of this lure in the trap, all alternative food sources should be removed or made unavailable to rats and mice as much as possible. Application of this lure may result in staining of surfaces near the application site.



To install, first remove the 10c coin to activate the ALP.



Shape the ALP into the A24's cap, remove the lid and wipe the excess lure below the trap.



Thread the ALP into the top of the trap and screw the cap on to secure into place.




RETAIN PACKAGING INFORMATION FOR FUTURE REFERENCE
