DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To be used only in the manufacture of a herbicide which is registered under the *Pest Control Products Act*.

PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL.

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Avoid contact with skin. Wear goggles or face shield. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL AND USE PRECAUTIONS

Do not discharge effluent containing this active ingredient into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans and public waters. Spilled material should be soaked up with absorbent material and disposed in approved manner. For guidance contact your Provincial Regulatory Agency or the manufacturer.

FIRST AID

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF IN THE EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Treat symptomatically. There is no specific antidote. Supportive care is recommended. Treatment is based on the judgment of the physician in response to reactions of the patient.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, seed or feed by storage and disposal.

STORAGE: Store in original container in secured dry storage area. Prevent cross-contamination with other pesticides and fertilizers. Do not store above 38°C (100°F) for extended periods of time. If container is damaged or spill occurs, use product immediately or dispose of product and damaged container as indicated below.

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DISPOSAL AND DECONTAMINATION: Canadian manufacturers should dispose of unwanted active ingredients and containers in accordance with municipal or provincial regulations. For additional details and clean up of spills, contact manufacturer or the provincial regulatory agency.
