Specially formulated to kill dog and cat fleas and American Brown and dog ticks for 2 weeks. Kills deer ticks which may carry the organism which causes Lyme Disease. Contains special conditioning agents that actually return your pet's coat to it's shiny, natural lustre.

DIRECTIONS: Hold container 25-30 cm from pet and spray entire body beginning at tail and working towards the head. Do not spray face, eyes or genitals. As you spray, fluff the hair so that spray will penetrate to the skin until the hair is wet. Spray ticks directly. Spray pet's bed and living quarters, if needed. Do not use on nursing puppies under 8 weeks of age, or

on nursing or pregnant females, sick animals or on animals under drug or pesticide treatment. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray more than once a week.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat or store at temperatures over 50 deg Celsius. Do not spray in eyes, or face, or on genitals. Discontinue use if dermal or nasal irritation develops. Do not use near birds, fish, food or foodstuffs. Avoid inhalation of spray. Avoid skin contact, wear rubber gloves, wash hands after use.

FIRST AID: If sprayed in your eyes, flush with clean water. If irritation persists, obtain medical attention. If accidentally swallowed, obtain medical attention at once. If on skin, wash thoroughly with soap and water. TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: contains a cholinesterase inhibitor: atropine sulphate is antidotal.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty press valve to release pressure, dispose in household garbage. Do not reuse container.
