DIRECTIONS: Use to control unwanted weeds and grass on patios, paths, parking areas or where bare soil is required.

- 1. Apply using the trigger sprayer supplied.
- 2. Unscrew original cap from container and retain in the plastic sprayer bag.
- 3. Place tube through hole in the other cap, then insert tube into bottle and screw on cap.
- 4. Open nozzle about one turn.
- 5. Point nozzle at desired area and pump trigger until spray begins.
- 6. Adjust nozzle to get a coarse spray pattern.
- 7. When temporarily not in use, keep trigger spray above liquid level of container to prevent leakage from nozzle. To store, remove sprayer and carefully drain tube into bottle by squeezing trigger.
- 8. Re cap container with original cap.

Spray to wet foliage thoroughly or apply at the rate of 2 litres per 6.5 m2 for light sandy soil or 5 m2 for heavy soil.

Hold sprayer close to weed (30cm to 60cm) and spray to cover centre of weed. One application will kill most weeds and grasses. Repeat application in 2 to 3 weeks if necessary.

DO NOT USE on desirable vegetation such as lawns, shrubs, trees or crops or on soil required for planting within two years.

Do not apply over roots of trees, hedges, shrubs or woody ornamental plants or within 30 cm of lawn grasses. Avoid spray drift onto garden plants.

## PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. May irritate eyes, nose, throat and skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Do not breathe spray mist. Wash thoroughly after use. Avoid contamination of feed or food.
