SUGGESTED USE: For control of Norway rats (*Rattus norvegicus*),

Roof rats (*Rattus rattus*) and house mice (*Mus musculus*) in and around homes, industrial and agricultural buildings, and similar man-made structures. This product can be used in wet or damp areas, such as river banks, gullies, irrigation ditches, sewers, garbage dumps, landfills, etc.

EATON'S All-Weather Bait Pellets must be placed in tamper-proof bait boxes or in locations not accessible to children, pets, domestic animals or non-target wildlife. Do not place bait in areas where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come indirect contact with food.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where rats and/or mice will most likely find and consume bait. Generally these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in or beside burrows, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls or in locations where rodents or their signs have been observed. Protect bait from rain or snow. Remove as much food as possible.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

RATS: Apply 113-454 grams (usually at intervals of 4-9 meters) of bait per placement. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 10 days or until signs of rat activity cease.

HOUSE MICE: Open a pack and apply 7-14 grams of bait at 2-3.5 meter intervals. Large placements (up to 57 grams) may be needed at points of high mouse activity. Maintain an uninterrupted supply of fresh bait for at least 15 days or until signs of mouse activity cease.

RATS & MICE: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. Collect and dispose of all dead animals and uneaten bait properly. To prevent reinfestation, eliminate food, water and harbourage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment. Where a continuous source of infestation is present, establish permanent bait stations and replenish bait as needed.
