DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply sufficient Sanibrom S45 Biocide and an oxidant such as chloride, sodium hypochlorite or trichloro-s-triazenetrione to achieve a residual bromine level of 0.5 - 0.9 ppm. A 0.5 to 2.0 mole ratio of sodium bromide to oxidant is recommended. Based on 1:1 mole ratio. 0.4 kg chlorine gas is recommended per litre of Sanibrom S45 biocide.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN**

Avoid contact with eyes and skin. May cause eye and skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed. Wash well after handling and before eating, drinking and smoking. Wash contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before reuse. Do not wear contaminated shoes. Do not contaminate irrigation water, lakes, streams or ponds by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

FIRST AID

In case of contact in eyes or on skin, flush thoroughly with water for 15 minutes. For eye contact, get medical attention. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.
