PRECAUTIONS : KEEP OUT OF REACH OF UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. CAUTION: EYE AND SKIN IRRITANT. MAY BE HARMFUL IF INHALED. Do not inhale vapours or spray mist. Do not get in eyes.
