2004 Germicidal Detergent is recommended for use in all areas where cleaning and disinfection is required in one procedure... such as hospitals, health care institutions, schools, clubs, hotels, animal care establishments.

DIRECTIONS:

FLOORS and HARD SURFACES: Remove loose soil particles with treated dusting tool and use as follows:

1. General Cleaning, Disinfection and Deodorizing: 12-25 mL per L (1:80 to 1:40) of warm water depending on degree of soil. For the complete sanitation of pseudomonas infected wards, use 50 mL per L of water (1:20). Always rinse conductive floors with clear warm water.
2. Daily Damp Mopping: 6-12 mL per L of cold water (1:160 - 1:80).

NOTE:

1. Apply with clean applicators. Scrub if necessary.
2. Treated surfaces should remain wet with diluted 2004 solution for at least 10 minutes.
3. Rinse as often as possible.
4. Pick up dirty solutions for discarding.
5. Renew 2004 solution when soiling becomes noticeable.
6. Wash mops and equipment with 1:80 solution of 2004 when daily procedure is finished.

Do not mix 2004 with other detergents or disinfectants. If used on metal surfaces add 6g sodium nitrite per litre of diluted solution.

PRECAUTIONS: Keep out of the reach of children.

DANGER: Toxic if swallowed. Extremely corrosive to eyes. Avoid contact with eyes or skin. Do not contaminate food or use on animals. Wear chemical goggles and polygloves when handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

FIRST AID:

In case of contact with eyes or skin, flush with copious amounts of water for 15 minutes.

For eyes, CONSULT A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.

If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Promptly drink large quantities of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or water. CALL A PHYSICIAN or POISON CONTROL CENTRE IMMEDIATELY.

DISPOSAL:

1. Rinse the emptied container thoroughly and add the rinsings to treatment site.
2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
3. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
