CARROTS PARSNIPS	CARROT RUST FLY LARVAE	9.5 grams*	Apply in seed furrow at planting.
ONIONS ALL TYPES	ONION MAGGOTS	9.5 grams*	
RADISHES	ROOT MAGGOTS	17.5 grams*	

TURNIPS	ROOT MAGGOTS	42.5 grams*	Apply in seed furrow at planting. Two weeks after thinning make a 2nd application in a narrow band over row.
CORN	CORN ROOTWORMS	20 grams*	Apply in 20 cm band over row at planting time.
CABBAGE, CAULI- FLOWER, BROCCOLI, BRUSSEL SPROUTS.	In Seedbed - ROOT MAGGOTS	15 grams*	Apply in seed furrow at planting.
	Transplants- ROOT MAGGOTS	75 grams*	Apply to soil in 10 cm radius around stem of plant soon after transplanting.

\* 1 tablespoon = 9 grams.

#### DIRECTIONS:

Apply evenly. Avoid possible crop injury in sandy soils by separating seed from insecticide by 6 mm of soil. To help prevent ants, clover mites, crickets, earwigs, fleas, millipedes and sow bugs from entering the house, apply a 1.5 metre wide band treatment around the foundation at the rate of 200 g per 10 square meters. Spread granules right up to foundation.

#### PRECAUTIONS:

May be fatal if swallowed. May be absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wash thoroughly after handling. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Dispose of empty container with household garbage.

#### FIRST AID INSTRUCTIONS:

If swallowed, induce vomiting and obtain medical attention immediately. If in eyes, flush with water for 5-10 minutes. If irritation develops, seek medical attention. If on skin, wash thoroughly with soap and water.

#### TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Diazinon is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.
