DIRECTIONS FOR USE

COOLING WATER SYSTEMS

For the control of algae, bacteria, and fungi in commercial and industrial cooling water systems, add this products as follows:

Initial dose: 20-120 mL per 1,000 L water in the system.

Maintenance dose: Every 1 to 5 days or as needed, 6.4 to 40 mL per 1,000 L of water in the system.

DISPOSAL

1. Rinse the emptied container thoroughly and add the rinsings to the treatment site.
2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
3. Make the container unsuitable for further use.
4. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
5. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product and the cleanup of spills contact the Provincial Regulatory Agency or the Manufacturer.

PRECAUTION

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

DANGER: Corrosive, causes eye and skin damage. Skin sensitizer. Harmful if swallowed. Workmen handling the product should wear chemical resistant gloves, safety glasses of face shield and body-protective clothing and shoes. Contact of the product with clothing or skin should be avoided. Keep the container closed when not in use. Do not reuse the container. Destroy when empty. Refer to the Material Safety Data Sheet.

FIRST AID

Eye exposure: Flush with clean, cool water for at least 15 minutes or longer till irritation subsides. See a physician if irritation occurs.

Skin exposure: Wash with a mild soap and water. See a physician if irritation occurs. Remove and wash contaminated clothing (including shoes) before reuse.

Inhalation: Use proper respiratory protection to immediately remove the affected person from exposure. Administer artificial respiration if breathing has stopped. Keep at rest. Get prompt medical attention.

Ingestion: DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Rinse mouth with copious amounts of water or milk, first. Irrigate the esophagus and dilute stomach contents by slowly giving one (1) to two (2) glasses of water or milk. Avoid giving alcohol or alcohol related products. In cases where the individual is semi-comatose, comatose or convulsing, DO NOT GIVE FLUIDS BY MOUTH. In all cases, seek immediate medical assistance.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Note to physician: Probable mucosal damage following ingestion may contraindicate gastric lavage.

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
