Hex is a scientific combination of quat and high grade chemicals designed for the control of odour in and around sewage disposal plants, storm sewers, drainage ditches, garbage areas, etc. Hex is not recommended for use in food manufacturing and processing plants. Hex removes grease and slime from lines and systems. Hex is an effective disinfectant and deodorizer having a high detergency for removal of grease and soil from incinerator rooms and garbage areas.

DIRECTIONS:

FOR ODOUR CONTROL:

Dilution

Odour Control Sewage Plants	1 to 50 parts water
Garbage Areas and Disposal Containers	1 to 100 parts water
Incinerators, Chutes and Compactors	1 to 50 parts water
Sump Pits	1-2 to 80 parts water
Drainage Ditches and Storm Sewers	1 to 50 parts water
Smoke and Fire Damage	1 to 50 parts water

FOR DISINFECTION: Prepare solution of Hex at the above dilutions and spray this solution over entire area. For cleaning, deodorizing and disinfecting concrete and painted walls, etc., use Hex 1-2 parts per 80 parts water, and wash in normal way.

CAUTION:

Hex should not be used in areas where food is prepared or handled. Avoid contamination of food. Avoid ingestion. Keep out of the reach of children.

FIRST AID: In case of skin contact, wash with soap and water for 5 to 10 minutes. If eye contact occurs, flush well with clean water for 15 minutes and consult physician. If ingested, remove unabsorbed detergent by gastric lavage or emesis with tap water followed by catharsis.

NOTICE TO USER: This control product is to be used in accordance with the directions on this label. It is an offence under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT to use a control product under unsafe conditions.

DISPOSAL:

1. Triple or pressure rinse the emptied container thoroughly and add the rinsings to the spray mixture in the tank.
2. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal or reconditioning.
3. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
4. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product

and the cleanup of spills, contact the Provincial Regulatory Agency or the Manufacturer.

5. For small spills. Recover free liquid. Soak up residue with solids absorbent. DO NOT FLUSH INTO SURFACE STREAMS. INFORM PROVINCIAL REGULATORY AGENCY OR THE MANUFACTURER AS IN #4.
