DIRECTIONS FOR USE: AREAS OF USE: Dwellings, Farm Buildings, Food Service Establishments, Granary Bins (empty), Processing Plants (feed, food & non-food) and Storage Areas (feed, food & non-food).

METHOD: Place bait in protected locations or bait stations where rats consume feed and water, or travel. Keep bait in place for one month. Check bait at least twice during the first week and once each week for the next three weeks. Replace wet or spoiled bait on each inspection.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. If taken in large or repeated doses by humans or animals, it may reduce clotting ability of the blood and cause internal bleeding. Place baits in protected places inaccessible to children and domestic animals or

in tamper-proof bait boxes. Do not contaminate food or feed. Do not contaminate any body of water. Burn or bury bodies of dead rodents.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with a finger or blunt object; repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Rush patient to nearest hospital taking this labelled container with you.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Blood transfusions combined with intravenous injections and oral doses of Vitamin K1 are indicated, as for haemorrhage caused by overdoses of dicumarol. Vitamin K1 in the form of intravenous, intramuscular or subcutaneous injections, or by oral ingestion are suggested remedial treatments for anticoagulant poisoning. The severity of the case measured by establishing prolonged prothrombin times (P.T.) will determine appropriate therapy. Monitoring P.T. will indicate the necessity of repeated treatments.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place away from food and feed.

DISPOSAL:

- 1. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal.
- 2. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use.
- 3. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements.
