DIRECTIONS: Wet dog's coat thoroughly with water. Rub shampoo into coat, starting with head. Work backward until coat is

completely covered with foamy lather. Let lather stay on 5 minutes, then rinse and towel dry. Keep away from pet's eyes. Repeat as required. Wash hands after use. For effective flea and tick control, treatment of the pet should be combined with the cleanup and sanitation of any area used by the pet. Vacuum floors, carpets, furniture, etc. (discard vacuum bag after use) and wash the pet's bedding, living quarters, and surrounding areas. If pest problems persist, an insecticidal premise treatment may be required.

PRECAUTIONS: Avoid contact with eyes of animal. Consult a veterinarian before treating pregnant or sick animals under drug treatment. It is not advisable to use this product or similar pesticides on puppies less than 8 weeks old. Discontinue use if adverse effects are observed. Do not use near birds or fish.

FIRST AID: If in eyes, flush with clean water. If irritation persists, consult a physician.

DISPOSAL: Wrap and discard empty container with household garbage.
