DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

GARDENS:

CROP	PEST	DOSAGE
Vegetables and Flowers	Cutworms	Sprinkle 80 grams (8 tbsp.) on 10 square meters (5 paces x 2 paces) of garden soil and work in to a depth of 8-15 cm (3-6 inches) before seeding or transplanting vegetables and flowers.
Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower	Root maggots	10 grams (1 tablespoon) per 10 m of row in the furrow with seeds or 3 grams (1 teaspoon) per plant after transplanting.
Carrots, Onions	Rust Fly maggots, Onion maggots	10 grams (1 tablespoon) per 10 m of row in furrow with seeds.
Radishes	Root maggots	17.5 grams (1 3/4 tablespoons) per 10 m of row in furrow with seeds.
Turnips	Root maggots	30 grams (3 tablespoons) per 10 m of row in furrow with seeds. Make a second application directly over the row 2 weeks after thinning. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.

LAWNS AND FLOWER GARDENS:

PEST	DOSAGE
Sod Webworms, Sowbugs	Spot treat only in areas of infestation using 9 grams of product (3 teaspoon) per sq. metre.
Chinch bugs	Spot treat only in areas of infestation using 20 grams per sq. metre (6 ½ teaspoons) per sq. metre of lawn. Water lightly before and after application.
Earwigs	Spot treat only in areas of infestation using 20 grams per sq. metre (6 ½ teaspoons) per sq. metre of lawn.

SPOT TREATMENTS:

ANTS: Apply 3 grams (1 teaspoonful) around and on top of each ant hill.

DIGGER WASPS: 3 grams (1 teaspoonful) in and around each ground nest opening in late evening when wasps are not active.

FISH & WILDLIFE CAUTION:

This product is toxic to bees, fish and wildlife. Do not contaminate domestic or irrigation water supplies, lakes, streams and ponds.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN & ANIMALS. When applying to lawns wear a long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes and socks and chemical resistant (e.g. rubber) gloves during handling, application and watering-in. Rinse gloves before removal. Do not treat areas greater than 450 sq. metres (5,000 sq. ft.) in one day. Keep people off treated lawns for 24 hours following application and watering-in. May be fatal if swallowed. May be absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wash thoroughly after handling. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

FIRST AID:

If swallowed, induce vomiting and obtain medical attention or contact a Poison Control Centre immediately. If in eyes, flush 5-10 minutes with water. If irritation develops, seek medical attention. If on skin, wash thoroughly with soap and water. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:

Diazinon is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.

DISPOSAL:

Do not reuse container. Wrap and dispose of empty container with household garbage.
