Thoroughly clean all traces of FIRE DF Herbicide from application equipment immediately after use. Flush tank, pump, hoses, and boom with several changes of water after removing nozzle tips and screens (clean these parts separately).

Wash away any spray mixture from the outside of spray tank, nozzle or spray rig.

NOTE: Do not use on muck soil or subsequent crops may be injured.

Rotation crops such as onion, celery, peppers, cole crops, lettuce, spinach, sugar beets, table beets, turnips, pumpkin, squash, cucumbers, melons, tobacco, and canola are sensitive to FIRE DF Herbicide and may be injured if planted in FIRE DF Herbicide treated soil both during the year of application and the following crop year. Applications of FIRE DF Herbicide made at rates above those recommended may result in burning, yellowing or stunting of the crop. If heavy rains occur soon after application, plant injury may result, especially in poorly drained areas where water may stand for several days.

Uneven application such as swath overlapping, variable tractor speed, spraying on turns, etc., may result in crop injury and increase chance of injury to rotation crops.

GENERAL INFORMATION

DUPONT FIRE DF Herbicide TOSS-N-GO BAGS should be used only in accordance with recommendations on this label, or in separate published DuPont recommendations available through local dealers.

FIRE DF Herbicide TOSS-N-GO BAGS are a dry flowable granule contained within a water soluble film. The water soluble film dissolves readily in water. Use gloves and goggles when handling the water soluble bags. Reseal unused TOSS-N-GO BAGS into foil bag when not in use. Avoid exposure of the TOSS-N-GO BAGS to excessive moisture or physical damage during storage and prior to mixing in the spray tank. Do not reuse foil bags.

FIRE DF Herbicide is intended for use as a post-emergent spray for selective control of broadleaf weeds in spring wheat and spring barley (Western Canada only). It is non-corrosive to equipment, non-flammable and non-volatile.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

EQUIPMENT: Use a fixed-boom power spray properly calibrated to ensure a constant rate of application. Opening in screens should be equal to or larger than 50 mesh. Agitate by mechanical or hydraulic means in the spray tank. If by-pass or return line is used, it should terminate at bottom of tank to minimize foaming.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Fill tank about 1/4 full with fresh water.
2. Turn on full agitation.
3. Add the required number of FIRE DF TOSS-N-GO BAGS. Maintain full agitation until bags are completely dissolved and product is fully dispersed.
4. Continue filling tank with water and add tank mix partners (if applicable) in the following sequence:
 - Dry formulations
 - Liquid formulations
 - Emulsifiable concentrates
 - Anti-foam agents

Continue with full agitation. On repeat tank loads, ensure that the amount of spray solution left in the tank from the previous load is less than 10% of the volume about to be mixed.

FIRE DF TOSS-N-GO HERBICIDE PLUS BANVEL* OR MCPA AMINE 500

Use FIRE DF TOSS-N-GO alone, or tank mixed with BANVEL or MCPA Amine 500. Crop must be planted 5 cm deep and not underseeded with forages. Apply only once per season. Apply in 80-100 L water per ha when weeds are small.

Weed control may not be noticeable for 7 to 10 days. Temporary (7-10 days) lightening in crop colour and occasionally a slight reduction in crop height may be observed, especially if frost or abnormally high temperatures occur within 1-2 days of application.

If frost occurs, allow 4-5 days for crop to recover before applying FIRE DF TOSS-N-GO.

Allow a 4-5 day interval between application of FIRE DF TOSS-N-GO and wild oat herbicides. Do not use on the Klondike variety of barley. Refer to the BANVEL or MCPA Amine 500 labels for recommendations, directions for use, and restrictions.

WEEDS CONTROLLED:

Ball mustard	Smartweed

Use the higher rate for best residual control of chickweed or when weed infestation is dense.

Rainfall immediately after application may reduce weed control. Do not apply within 60 days of harvest. Do not graze or feed crop to livestock within 30 days of application.

2-5 leaf stage mid-tillering of barley and wheat

FIRE DF TOSS-N-GO + Banvel

2-3 leaf stage of barley and wheat (may be extended to the 4 leaf stage of wheat, but crop tolerance may be reduced)

FIRE DF TOSS-N-GO + MCPA Amine 500

3-5 leaf stage mid-tillering of barley and wheat.
