DIRECTIONS: Hold container approximately 30 cm from surface being sprayed and spray until wet. Thorough applications produce a cooling which will vaporize into cracks and crevices for insect control. I reinfestations occur, repeat

applications as necessary. Provide adequate ventilation after indoor use. KEEP PETS AND CHILDREN AWAY FROM SURFACE UNTIL DRY FOR COCKROACHES, CRICKETS, CENTIPEDES, SPIDERS, EARWIGS. Thoroughly treat cracks and crevices, baseboards, underneath chairs, tables, kitchen shelves, cupboards, sinks refrigerators, around your garbage container and other places where insects habitate.

FOR ANTS:

Treat and trails, around door sills and window frames and other places where ants may enter. Apply directly to ant hills.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Contents under pressure. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat, or store at temperatures over 50°C. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Do not spray near open flame or spark.

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing.

DO NOT USE ON HUMANS, ANIMALS, PLANTS, FOODSTUFFS, FOOD UTENSILS, FISH BOWLS OR ANIMAL FEED AREAS. DO NOT USE AS A SPACE SPRAY.

FIRST AID TREATMENT:

Contains volatile petroleum distillate. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call physician or Poison Control Centre immediately. Propoxur is a mild cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal. In case of contact with the skin, wash with soap and water. If in eyes, flush with water for 15 minutes, get medical attention.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press button to release all pressure, then dispose in household garbage. Do not puncture or incinerate.
