READY-TO-USE

CONTROLS MOST COMMON LAWN WEEDS

Made in Canada

Controls: Dandelions, Plantains, Chickweed, Clover, Creeping Charlie, Knotweed, Ragweed, etc.

Directions: Keep from freezing. Apply when weeds are actively growing. Do not water for 24 hours. Rain within 6 hours reduces effectiveness. Spray acts within a few days and weeds gradually die. Grass fills in as weeds disappear. Some weeds may require up to 4 weeks for complete control. Repeat in 3-4 weeks if necessary. For numerous weed, spray overall with Spray & Green 15-5-5 Lawn Fertilizer and Weed Control.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful to some

desirable plants. Avoid spraying flowers, shrubs, vegetable fruit crops. Wash hands after use. Bent grass may be injured. Do not store near seeds, fertilizers, insecticides or fungicides. Keep from freezing.

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING: Wear long sleeved shirt, long pants, socks and shoes.

OPERATOR USE PRECAUTIONS: Wash hands before eating, drinking, using tobacco or using the toilet. After treating, wash thoroughly. If pesticide penetrates clothing, remove immediately, then wash contaminated skin thoroughly and shower. Launder contaminated clothing separately before reuse.

RE-ENTRY INTERVAL: Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treated areas until spray has thoroughly dried.

FIRST AID:

If on skin, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin with soap and water. If in eyes, flush with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention. If swallowed, rinse mouth with water. Drink water to dilute. Call doctor or Poison Control Centre.

DISPOSAL: Do not re-use empty container. Wrap in newspaper and dispose of empty container in household garbage.

READY-TO-USE

Important applicator information:

1. Place the hose of the sprayer in container and screw down cap.
2. Turn the sprayer nozzle clockwise to the fully closed position.
3. Turn the nozzle or counter clockwise 3/4 of a turn. This will produce a jet stream. (Remember, sprayer is fully adjustable - from jet stream to fine spray, simply by turning the nozzle clockwise.)
4. Hold the container in one hand, level with the sprayer in the other.
5. While holding the sprayer in a pistol position, aim towards the ground (avoid spraying plants or other desirable

vegetation) and squeeze the trigger several times until the product sprays from the nozzle. Adjust nozzle to give coarse wet stream. Aim at weed; pull trigger. Only short burst necessary.

6. After completing Step 5, both sprayer and container may be held in any position that is convenient for you.
7. When not in use, keep nozzle above liquid level of container to prevent leakage from nozzle. Turn the sprayer nozzle clockwise, to the fully closed position. Keep container tightly closed, when not in use. Store in original container, in a dry secured storage area.
8. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Wash hands thoroughly after each use. Avoid contact with dip tube.
