DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Attach spray bottle to garden hose by connecting coupling nut tightly to hose and turning until black arrow aligns with OFF position. Turn water on at faucet. Push dark green button up and turn bottle until button seats into notch 1 or 2 (see below). To start spraying, turn coupling nut to align black arrow with ON. To spray water only, or for storage purposes, turn bottle until dark green button clicks to

"W" notch. To stop spraying, turn coupling nut to align black arrow with OFF.

APPLICATION:

Setting "W": Water only (no chemical). Storage Position.

Setting 1: For chinch bugs and clover mites: spray thoroughly wetting grass - apply 45 mL per 10 square metres. Repeat in 7 days.  
For ants, sod webworms, leather jackets - apply 30 mL per 10 square metres. Repeat as necessary.

Setting 2: For control of insects, aphids, carrot rust fly, caterpillars, fleabeetle, fruit fly, leafhopper, leafminer, mealybug, mite, pine shoot moth, potato beetle, rose chafer, scales, thrips, root maggot.

CROPS OR PLANTS: apple, apricot, cherry, grape, peach, pear, plum, strawberry, bean, beet, broccoli, cabbage, carrot, cauliflower, celery, cucumber, lettuce, onion, parsnip, pepper, potato, radish, spinach, tomato, azalea, birch, boxwood, carnation, cedar, crabapple, fir, ivy, juniper, mums, oak, pine, spruce, rose, yew: - spray when insects are first noticed: repeat

as needed. For carrot rust fly maggot and fruit fly maggots, spray every week between June 20 and July 31st. Do not apply to a food crop within 10 days of harvest, except for the following limitations: tomato - 1 day; cauliflower, broccoli, pepper, strawberry - 5 days; beans, cabbage, cucumber - 7 days; apple, pear, beet, potato - 14 days; grape & peach - 20 days.

CUTWORMS ON ALL VEGETABLES: Apply 60 mL on 9 square metres before planting and rake in 8 to 10 cm deep.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get into eyes. Avoid contact with skin or inhaling spray mist. Wash thoroughly after handling. Avoid contaminating food or feed. This product is poisonous to bees, fish and wildlife; spray flowers in late evening only; do not contaminate water supplies, ponds, etc. Avoid drift, spray when winds are calm.

DISPOSAL: Wrap and dispose of empty unit in regular garbage. NOT REFILLABLE. DO NOT REUSE.

FIRST AID: Product contains petroleum distillates; if swallowed,

do not cause vomiting but rush patient to a hospital taking this labelled container with you. If in eyes, flush with clear water for 15 minutes and get medical attention. If patient is unconscious, give him air.

TOXICOLOGY: Stomach lavage. Diazinon is an organophosphorous. Cholinesterase inhibitor; atropine is antidotal.
