#### PRECAUTIONS

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

#### FIRST AID

If a known exposure occurs or is suspected, immediately initiate the recommended procedures below. If further treatment is required, contact Poison Control Centre, a physician, or the nearest hospital.

If Swallowed: Immediately give several glasses of water and induce

vomiting by gagging the victim with a finger or blunt object placed on the back of the victim's tongue. Give fluids until vomitus is clear. If victim is unconscious, do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth.

If in Eyes: Immediately flush eyes with large amounts of running water for at least 15 minutes. Hold eyelids apart during flushing to ensure rinsing of the entire surface of the eye and lids with water. Get medical attention.

If on Skin: Flush all affected areas with plenty of water for 15 minutes. Remove contaminated clothing and shoes. Seek medical attention if skin irritation occurs. Wash clothing before reuse.

If Inhaled: Remove to fresh air. Seek medical attention if respiratory irritation occurs or if breathing becomes difficult.

#### STORAGE

Store in a cool dry well ventilated area away from foodstuffs and out of reach of children and animals. This product is not affected by freezing.

#### SPILL CLEANUP

Wear Appropriate protective equipment (gloves, glasses, apron) when attempting to clean up the spill. If the container is leaking, secure leak and place the container into a drum or heavy gauge plastic bag. Contact ZENECA Agro (See EMERGENCY NUMBER) for further information.

For spills and leaks; clean up as much of the product as possible with a broom and shovel. If available, use an absorbent such as DUSTBANE to clean the spill area. Shovel the spilled product and spend absorbent in sealed waste container.

On hard surfaces - sprinkle spill area with detergent and scrub in a small quantity of water with a coarse broom. Let stand for 10 minutes then absorb onto an inert material and shovel waste into a waste container.

On soil - remove the top 15 cm of soil in the spill area and replace with fresh soil. Dispose of all waste including scrub brush in accordance with provincial requirements. For more information on the disposal of waste at the clean up of spills, contact the regional office of Conservation and Protection, Environment Canada.

#### DISPOSAL

Rinse the empty container thoroughly and add the rinsings to the spray mixture in the tank. Follow provincial instructions for any required additional cleaning of the container prior to its disposal. Make the empty container unsuitable for further use. Dispose of container in accordance with provincial requirements. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product and the cleanup of spills, contact the regional office of Conservation and Protection, Environment Canada.

Chipman Microfine Sulphur 92 is a high quality wettable sulphur for spray or dust application. It is compatible with the commonly used insecticides and fungicides except oil.

#### NOTICE TO USER

This control product is to be used only in accordance with the directions on this label. It is an offence under the Pest Control Products Act to use a control product under unsafe conditions.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Sulphur should not be used in combination with, immediately before or immediately after an oil spray. Sulphur sprays should not be applied when temperature is above 30°C.

CROPS	DISEASES	RATE	REMARKS
Apples	Apple Scab	20 to 27 kg/ha	In pre-pink, blossom and calyx sprays, use 27 kg/ha In cover sprays use 20 kg/ha.
Peaches Sweet Cherries and Plums	Brown Rot Scab Leaf Spot	20 to 27 kg/ha	Use in all sprays where sulphur is recommended.
Sour Cherries	Brown Rot	20 to 27 kg/ha	Use in spray just before blossoms open. For other sprays use ZENECA Ferbam.
Gooseberries	Powdery Mildew	27 kg/ha	Do not use on "sulphur-shy" American varieties.
Roses, Chrysanthemums and other Ornamentals	Powdery Mildew	20 kg/ha	Apply on appearance of disease.

Cucumbers (Greenhouse)	Powdery Mildew	150 g product	Apply to runoff using a backpack or other suitable sprayer, at weekly intervals as needed to combat powdery mildew. Leave at least 1 day between last treatment and harvest of fruit.
