DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a pesticide which is registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT.

PRECAUTIONS:

PREVENT ACCESS BY UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL. Corrosive - causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not store on side. Avoid creasing or impacting of side walls. Avoid contamination of food.

NOTE: This product should not be used or compounded with any reducing or oxidizing agents (such as calcium hypochlorite, solid perchlorate or nitric acid) since such admixtures may be explosive.

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters.

Do not use in conjunction with soap or any anionic wetting agent.

Keep above 5 deg C. The effectiveness of Bio-Quat 80-28R is not reduced by low temperatures. It is a concentrated product and may crystallize or gel below 5 deg C. Before use, stir thoroughly to insure uniformity. Keep container closed to avoid loss of solvent.

FIRST AID:

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician or poison control centre immediately. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION:
