DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Be sure that spray tank is clean. Mix Later's Summer Oil thoroughly with water before applying. If the mixture becomes milky white it indicates good emulsification. Do not use if it does not emulsify. If the mixture does not emulsify, add household detergent and mix until the oil disappears and the solution becomes milky white. Avoid overspraying or double spraying. Plants should be sprayed only when in a vigorous condition. Never use in the undiluted form as this will injure the foliage. Avoid spraying during or immediately prior to hot weather (over 30 deg. C), hot dry winds, rain or other unsuitable weather conditions. Spray when pests are present and as recommended below.

APPLE, PEAR, CHERRY, PEACH and PLUM - To control European red mites, mix 13 mL of Later's Summer Oil with 1 L of water and spray on the leaves. Do not over spray.

ORNAMENTALS and SHADE TREES such as holly, pyracantha, sycamore, hawthorne, flowering peach, flowering cherry, maple, dogwood, oak, privet and birch - To control scale insects and mite eggs, mix 13 mL of Later's Summer Oil with 1 L of water and spray on the plant. Do not use on conifers and ferns such as blue spruce, white pine, juniper and arborvitae, which are sensitive to oil sprays.

LIMITATIONS: Do not use on Japanese maple, beech, hickory, walnut or butternut as they may be injured. Do not apply to the Red Delicious apple variety. Do not apply to apple after the green - tips are 1.3 cm long or to pear after the green-tip stage.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Avoid inhalation of the spray mist. Keep in original container during storage. Dispose of empty container in household garbage. Do not contaminate food or feed. Do not contaminate irrigation water, streams, ponds, or water used by livestock or for domestic purposes. Fish and aquatic life may be killed by this product. Do not spray when run-off is likely to occur.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call a doctor immediately.
