WEEDRITE* is a non-volatile, very fast acting herbicide. Rain

falling shortly after application will not reduce effectiveness. WEEDRITE* Granules are simply dissolved in water and applied with a fine spray sprinkling can or low pressure garden sprayer, to thoroughly wet all unwanted weeds and grasses. WEEDRITE* can be applied between plants in flower and vegetable beds using a dribble-bar, along fences and ditches, driveways, paths and patios. Also, weeds and grasses can be controlled right up to the base of trees, hedges and shrubs that have been established for at least one year, as the spray will have no effect on mature brown bark. The spray must not contact green bark, other green growth or foliage of evergreens, as this may result in serious injury to the plant. Use the dribble-bar for added protection. WEEDRITE* becomes inactivated on contact with the soil, and cannot spread to untreated areas, to tree roots under the treated area, or affect seed or plants placed in treated soil 3 days or later after treatment. Remove dead vegetation before seeding any crop.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

APPLICATION: WATERING CAN WITH FINE SPRAY OR DRIBBLE-BAR: Dissolve the contents of one sachet (57g) in 10L of water and apply to 20m2 SPRAYER: (Use LOW pressure-large droplets): Dissolve the contents of one sachet (57g) in 10L of water and apply to 20m2. If weed growth is extremely dense, apply to 10m2. Add granules to CLEAN water and stir or shake for at least 1 minute to completely dissolve.

NOTE: Since soil inactivates the spray, use of muddy water, or spraying very dusty weeds will reduce effectiveness of WEEDRITE*. Spray or sprinkle to thoroughly wet unwanted grass and weeds, all green parts of plants treated will be killed. Apply any time during growing season, but control is best when grasses and weeds are young. Repeat as necessary. Most annual weeds and grasses are killed with one treatment. Control of perennial weeds will require repeat treatments.
