The new SQUAWKER from Phoenix Agritech (Canada) Ltd. is the most advanced bird deterrent system available today. Utilising the very latest sound technology, Squawker is able to reproduce actual alarm and distress calls of many species of pest birds coupled with the sound of predators and hunting sequences, giving Squawker an effectiveness which no other system can match.

In severe cases bird damage can account for the destruction of up to 40% of crops. Birds roosting on buildings can cause a mess and carry disease. Once Squawker has been set up, it can be left in place to deter the pest birds, giving your sites effective protection, day in and day out.

Each squawker comes with four pre-programmed sound sequences to suit your own geographic species specific requirements. Ask your dealer for a full list of further sounds currently available on optional pre-programmed cards. Squawker can be used to deter most common species of pest bird including: pigeons, geese, seagulls, crows and starlings.

Squawker is fitted with:

Volume control - which enables you to use the system in either an outside application, (e.g. fields or buildings.)

Light sensor - This control allows the user to adjust the light level at which the unit automatically switches itself on or off.

Time lapse control - This control allows the user to adjust time delay between program.

Program control - The Squawker has four pre-set programs installed, each of which represents a genuine hunting scenario. Each of the programs is controlled by the relevant switch, either 1, 2, 3 or 4.

This sequence is designed to create maximum confusion amongst the birds ensuring your crops remain protected for longer.
