Directions For Use

To be used only in the manufacture of a herbicide which is registered under the Pest Control Products Act. Read Technical Bulletin for formulation details.

In case of spillage or broken container, absorb the liquid onto soil, sawdust, or other suitable absorbent material and put into a closed container, and if not used, dispose of material in an approved disposal site in accordance with approved local procedures.
