Sulfodene (R) SCRATCHEX (R) Flea and Tick Spray has been scientifically formulated to kill both fleas and ticks. It can also be used safely on pet's bedding, furniture and spot treatment of carpets.

Directions for Use: Shake the container well before using. Hold the container upright during use. Spray the animal from a distance of 25-30 cm. Start spraying at the tail, moving the

dispenser rapidly and making sure the animal's entire body is covered, including legs and under the body. Fluff the hair as you spray so spray will penetrate the skin. The spray should wet the ticks thoroughly. Repeat as needed. Use in pet's sleeping area or on bedding, furniture, and localized areas of walls, floors and carpeting to control reinfestation. This product is not to be used for total carpet treatment.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals - Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Do not spray in eyes, face or on genitalia. Before using on pregnant animals consult veterinarian. Do not use on nursing puppies or kittens under 3 months of age. Avoid contact with the skin or clothing. Do not use on sick animals. Do not use on animals under drugs or pesticide treatment. Do not treat nursing females.
