SANI CLEAN is a one-step disinfectant cleaner that is effective against a broad spectrum of bacteria, is virucidal, fungicidal and will prevent the growth of mold and mildew and their odours when used as directed. It is especially designed for schools, non-medical institutions and industry. SANI CLEAN is an effective one-step sanitizer-cleaner for use on non-food contact surfaces. When used as directed SANI CLEAN will deodorize surfaces in toilet areas, behind and under sinks and counters, garbage cans and garbage storage areas, and other places where bacterial growth can cause malodors.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Apply SANI CLEAN to walls, floors and other hard (inanimate) non-porous surfaces such as tables, chairs, countertops, sinks, tile, porcelain, and bedframes with a cloth, or mop so as to thoroughly wet surfaces. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning is required. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

DISINFECTION - To disinfect hard, non-porous surfaces, add 8 mL/L of water. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. At this dilution, SANI CLEAN has been found effective in the presence of 5% serum against the following organisms. Salmonella choleraesuis, Brevibacterium ammoniagenes, Escherichia coli, Klebsiella pneumonia, Salmonella schottmelleri, Salmonella typhi, Serratia marcescens, Shigella dysenteriae, Staphylococcus aureus, Streptococcus pyogenes, Streptococcus faecalis, Enterobacter aerogenes and Pseudomonas aeruginosa.

Fungicidal Performance: At 8mL/L SANI CLEAN is an effective fungicide against Trichophyton metagrophytes (the athlete's foot fungus) when used on surfaces such as locker rooms, dressing rooms, shower and bath areas, exercise facilities etc.

Mold & Mildew Control: At 8mL/L SANI CLEAN will effectively inhibit the growth of mold and mildew and the odours caused by them when applied to hard, non-porous surfaces (as indicated in general instructions above). Allow to dry on surface and repeat when mildew growth returns.

Virucidal Performance: at 8mL/L use-level SANI CLEAN was evaluated in the presence of 5% serum and found to be effective against the following viruses: Influenza a Brazil, Herpes Simplex and Vaccinia, on inanimate hard, non-porous environmental surfaces.

SANITIZING For sanitizing non food contact surfaces (such as floors, walls, tables, etc.) at 2.5mL/L use level, SANI CLEAN is an effective sanitizer against staphylococcus aureus and Klebsiella pneumoniae in the presence of 5% serum on hard, non-porous environmental surfaces. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 2 minutes.

NOTICE TO USER: This control product is to be used only in accordance with the directions on this label. It is an

offence under the Pest Control Products Act to use a control product under unsafe conditions.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.
