FIRST AID

If ingested, drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician or Poison Control Centre immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED - Remove victim to fresh air. Resuscitate as necessary.

IF ON SKIN - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected area with soap and water.

IF IN EYES - Flush eyes with water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION

Tetrachlorvinphos is of the organophosphate family and is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine administered intravenously in doses of 1-2 mg. at 10 minute intervals, is the drug of choice for treating cases of intoxication.

DISPOSAL

Follow provincial instructions for any required cleaning of the container prior to its disposal. Make the empty container

unsuitable for further use. Dispose of the container in accordance with provincial requirements. For information on the disposal of unused, unwanted product and the cleanup of spills, contact the Provincial Regulatory Agency or the Manufacturer.

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
