**DIRECTIONS:**

**Later's Weed-Stop Tri-Mix Lawn Weedkiller** controls  
Dandelions, Plantain, Orange Hawkweed, Chickweed, Clover,  
Bedstraw, Black Medic (Yellow Clover), Heal All, Ground Ivy  
(Creeping Charlie), Knotweed, Ragweed, Shepherd's Purse, Poison  
Ivy, Devil's Paint Brush, Buttercups and English Daisy. Treat  
lawn in spring, early summer or late fall, when weeds are  
actively growing with enough leaf area to absorb the chemical.  
Soil should be moist at the time of application. Spray to wet  
the leaves. Do not water lawn for 24 hours after application.  
Do not cut grass for 4 days before and after treatment. Repeat

treatment may be necessary on hard-to-kill or established weeds.

**Maximum Application Frequency:** For good turf/lawn management, normally two applications per year per treatment site are adequate. This does not include spot treatments. New lawns can be treated after the grass has been cut twice. Do not use on Bent grass.

5 mL = 1 teaspoon

15 mL = 1 tablespoon

1 m = approx. 1 long pace

10 m<sup>2</sup> = 5 m x 2 m

**HOW TO USE:** Mix 15 mL per 2 litres of water to cover 10 m<sup>2</sup>. Apply evenly over lawn or as a spot treatment.

**PRECAUTIONS:** KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Avoid contacting skin, eyes and clothing. **Protective Clothing:** Wear a long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes and chemical-resistant (e.g. rubber) gloves.

**Operator Use Precautions:** Rinse gloves before removal. Wash hands before eating, drinking, using tobacco or using the toilet. If pesticide penetrates clothing, remove immediately; then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water, then shower. Re-use gloves for pesticide application only.

**Re-entry Interval:** Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treated areas until spray has thoroughly dried.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** Do not contaminate streams, lakes or ponds. Keep spray drift away from desirable plants. Do not use treated grass clippings as a mulch. Do not use same sprayer for spraying insecticides and fungicides as used for weedkillers.

#### **FIRST AID:**

IF SWALLOWED, induce vomiting and contact a doctor or a poison control centre immediately.

IF IN EYES, flush with water for 15 minutes and get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN, wash with soap and water.

Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Products Registratin Number with you when seeking medical attention.

**STORAGE:** Keep product in original container. Store in a cool, dry place

away from food, feed, seeds, fertilizer, insecticides or fungicides.

**DISPOSAL:**

Do not re-use container. Rinse thoroughly and use rinse-water with regular spray. Wrap container in newspaper and dispose of in regular garbage.
