DIRECTIONS: For the control of wasps, bees, hornets, and yellow jackets. Remove protective cap and point the nozzle in the direction of the wasp nest or at the insect. Press the nozzle and completely saturate the nest from a distance of 2-2.5 metres (6-8 feet). To prevent insects from falling on skin or clothes, do not stand directly under nest. Allow sufficient time for the insects to become dead or moribund. Application to wasps' nests should be made in late evening or early morning (if possible) when insects are at rest.
