Notification Change

Controls ants, cockroaches, fleas ~~and bedbugs~~ in food processing and beverage plants, dairies, meat packing and processing plants, bakeries, warehouses, industrial plants, homes, apartments, offices, hotels, restaurants, and food service establishments.

DIRECTIONS:

Apply powder using a hand or pressure duster, into crack and crevices where insects breed and hide. A light dusting is all that is required. Leave undisturbed for two weeks. Reapply as necessary. Cover or remove, food, dishes, and cooking utensils before applying. Avoid pantry shelves and other places where food is stored. Apply dust only as a crack and crevice application.

CAUTION:

In meat packing and food processing plants, and food service establishments, only apply when plant is not in operation. No

exposed food products, ingredients or packaging materials to be left in the room. Cover food-handling equipment. Any treated surface that may contact meat food products or other food products should be washed and rinsed thoroughly with potable water after spraying and before reuse for food processing.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated place away from food and feed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating, drinking and smoking. Avoid breathing dust. Do not contaminate food or feed. Do not contaminate any body of water. Do not spill or dump in areas underlain by roots of valuable plants.

SYMPTOMS OF POISONING:

Ingestion and absorption may cause, nausea, vomiting, diarrhoea, abdominal cramps, skin rash, circulatory collapse, delirium, convulsions and coma. Chronic exposure may cause dry skin, skin rash and gastric disturbances.

FIRST AID:

In case of poisoning, call a physician or poison control centre immediately.

If swallowed, give the patient one or two glasses of water and cause vomiting by inserting finger down the throat. Repeat with water until vomit is clear. The patient should be lying down with the head below the level of the feet. Do not try to cause vomiting if the patient is unconscious or in a convulsive state.

If on skin, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly with soap and water.

If in eyes, flush with water for 15 minutes and obtain medical attention. Take container, label or product name and P.C.P. Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

DISPOSAL:

Make the empty container unsuitable for further use. Dispose of the empty container in accordance with provincial requirements. For information on disposal of unused, unwanted product and the cleanup of spills, contact the provincial regulatory agency or the manufacturer.
