WEEDS CONTROLLED: Bedstraw, Black Medick (Yellow-Clover), Buttercup, Chickweed, Clover, Creeping Charlie (Ground Ivy), Dandelion, Dock, English Daisy, Hawkbit (fall dandelion), Heal-All, Knotweed, Narrow-leaved Plantain, Ox-eye Daisy, Plantain, Poison Ivy, Ragweed, Sandwort, Shepherd's Purse, Speedwells, Stonecrop.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Mix 15 mL (1 tablespoon) in 1 litre of water and spray evenly over 6 square meters. Do not overlap areas already sprayed. Apply in May, June or September when

weeds are growing actively. Repeat application may be required for some species. DO NOT APPLY THE SPRAY SOLUTION OR ALLOW SPRAY TO DRIFT ONTO DESIRABLE TREES, SHRUBS, VEGETABLE GARDENS OR FLOWER BEDS. Do not apply in very hot, very dry or rainy weather. Do not apply to newly-seeded lawns until after third mowing. Do not use on Bent Grasses. Do not cut grass for several days after application. Do not water within 24 hours of application. Do not use dippings from a freshly sprayed lawn as mulch.

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING: Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes and chemical-resistant (e.g., rubber) gloves.

OPERATOR USE PRECAUTIONS: Rinse gloves before removal. Wash hands before eating, drinking, using tobacco or using the toilet. If pesticide penetrates clothing, remove immediately; then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water, then shower. Reuse gloves for pesticide application only.

MAXIMUM APPLICATION FREQUENCY: For good turf/lawn management, normally two applications per year per treatment site are adequate. This does not include spot treatments.

RE-ENTRY INTERVAL: Do not allow people (other than the applicator) or pets on the treatment area during application. Do not enter treated areas until spray has thoroughly dried.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Avoid inhaling spray mist. Do not use weedkiller sprayer for other uses.

FIRST AID: If in eyes, flush with water for 15 minutes and get medical attention. If on skin, wash thoroughly with soap and water. If swallowed, call poison control centre or get medical attention at once.

DISPOSAL: Wrap empty container in newspaper and dispose of empty container in household garbage. Do not re-use.
