DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Use to formulate finished water baits or formulating concentrates to control the house mouse, Norway rat and Roof rat in and around dwellings, farm buildings, food service establishments, granary bins (empty), processing plants (feed, food, non-food), storage areas (feed, food, non-food).
