Ready to Use Pet Shampoo For Dogs and Cats

DIRECTIONS:

Shake well before using. Wet dog or cat with warm water. Apply shampoo liberally beginning at the head and working backward until entire body is covered. Pay special attention to neck and hindquarters. Do not treat eyes, face or genital area of pet. For difficult infestations, allow lather to remain on animal for three to five minutes. Rinse thoroughly. Repeat as necessary.

PRECAUTIONS:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Do not contaminate food or feed. Keep away from animal's eyes and mouth. Wash hands after using. Do not use on animals under eight weeks of age. Do not treat

nursing or pregnant females. Do not use on sick animals. Do not use on animals under drug or pesticide treatment. Before use on pregnant animals consult a veterinarian. Discontinue use if adverse effects are observed.

FIRST AID:

If in eyes or on skin, flush with clean water. If irritation persists, obtain medical attention. If accidentally swallowed, obtain medical attention or call a Poison Control Centre at once.

DISPOSAL:

DO NOT REUSE CONTAINER. Wrap and dispose of empty container in household garbage.
