DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

To be used only in the manufacture of a herbicide that is registered under the Pest Control Products Act or a fertilizer pesticide that is registered under the Fertilizer Act. Read the technical bulletin for formulation details.

PRECAUTIONS:

FIRST AID:
