Sparkle is a high strength sodium hypochlorite solution which exhibits excellent algaecidal properties. Proper use of Sparkle in conjunction with a regular maintenance program will give you a sanitary pool, free of harmful micro-organisms.

Directions For Use:

1. Maintain proper daily levels as determined by testing kit:

2. Superchlorinate pool water initially with 1 litre of Sparkle per 10,000 litres of pool water.

3. For best results, superchlorinate at dusk.

4. Chlorinate daily to maintain proper chlorine residual with 250 millilitres of Sparkle per 100,000 litres of pool water.

NOTE: Hot weather, heavy pool usage, and rain may require higher dosages to maintain proper chlorine residuals.

- 5. Superchlorinate weekly with 1 litre per 10,000 litres if average daily temperature is 25'C 32'C. Otherwise, superchlorinate every other week.
- 6. For visible algae superchlorinate with 3 litres per 10,000 litres of pool water. Wait at least 24 hours and vacuum pool to remove dead algae.

NOTE: For outdoor pools, chlorine residuals can be stabilized from destruction by sun's rays by addition of proper quantity of cyanuric acid. For WADING POOLS, maintain a chlorine residual of 3-5 ppm by chlorinating daily. Add 45 mL of Sparkle for every 1,000 L of pool water.

PRECAUTIONS

Keep out of reach of children. Contains sodium hypochlorite and sodium hydroxide. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Harmful if swallowed. Dangerous gas formed when mixed with acid. Do not mix with any other chemicals.

FIRST AID

If splashed in eyes or on skin, flush thoroughly with water for 15 minutes. If eye irritation persists, get medical attention. If swallowed, give one or two glasses of milk and warm water, or egg whites. Follow with emetic and repeat until vomit is clear. Call a physician immediately and keep patient warm.

STORAGE

Store away from sunlight and in a cool place. USE AT ONCE. Stability maximum 6 months. Do not store in trunk of car for extended periods of time. Rinse container thoroughly before discarding. Do not reuse. To dispose of chemical, flush into sewer with large quantities of water.
