For use as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control insects listed on front-panel.

INDOOR USE: Thoroughly treat cracks, crevices, baseboards, underneath furniture and equipment, around garbage containers and other Places where insects habitate.

OUTDOOR USE: Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios, light fixtures and other places where insect may alight, or congregate and enter.

DIRECTIONS: Hold container approximately 30 cm. from surface being sprayed and spray until wet. Thorough applications Produce a coating which will vaporize into cracks and crevices for insect control. If reinfestation occur, repeat application. Provide adequate ventilation after indoor use. KEEP PETS AND CHILDREN AWAY FROM SURFACE UNTIL DRY.

In meat and food processing plants and food service establishments, treat only when plant is NOT in operation. Remove or cover all food packaging materials, and utensils and cover all food processing surfaces before spraying. After treatment, wash all surfaces that may contact food and rinse thoroughly with potable water before resuming. Do not use in rooms where milk is processed, handled or stored.
