**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

Dust directly from this canister or transfer to a hand duster. Cover foliage on both sides with a thin, uniform coating. For best results use when air is calm. This product may be applied up to 1 day before harvest and does not leave a poisonous residue.

<b>CROPS</b>	<b>INSECTS</b>	<b>REMARKS</b>
Broccoli, Cabbage, Cauliflower	Caterpillars	Use this dust as soon as any insect damage becomes apparent.
Cucumbers, Melon, Squash	Vine Borers, Squash Bugs, Cucumber Beetles	For Vine Borers keep BASE of the plants thoroughly dusted. Apply weekly starting when 1st true leaves appear.
Asparagus, Potatoes, Flowers	Asparagus Beetles, Colorado Potato Beetles, Aphids, Beetles, Loopers	Use this dust as soon as insects appear. For aphids, dust when plants are wet with dew.
Radish	Flea Beetles	Apply when insects are first noticed. Repeat as necessary.
Raspberries	Raspberry Fruit Worm, Sawfly	Apply when blossom buds appear and repeat just before blossoms open.
Currants	Imported Currant Worm	Apply soon after fruit set, repeat 1 week later.
Gooseberries	Fruitworm	Apply when berries turn red and webbing is noticed.
