DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Later's WEED-STOP® Spot Weed Killer is Ready-To-Use. Spray anytime weeds are actively growing. Do not apply when temperatures are expected to exceed 30°C or if rain is expected to occur within 24 hours following application. Will not harm grass when used as directed. Weeds in newly seeded lawns may be sprayed after lawn has been mowed 3 times.

IMPORTANT: Do not use for controlling weeds in vegetable gardens, flower beds or around shrubs or ornamental plants. Temporary discoloration may occur on Bentgrass, St. Augustine and Centipede lawns.

CONTROLS: Black Medic, Clover, Carpetweeds, Chickweed, Creeping Charlie, Cudweed, Curled Dock, Dandelion, English Daisy, Fall Hawkbit, Heal-all, Henbit, Pennywort, Plantains, Purslane, Sheep Sorrel, Spurges (annual), Sow Thistle, White Clover, Wild Carrot, Wild Onion, Canada Thistle.

HOW TO USE: Adjust spray nozzle to give a coarse spray. Aim at centre of weed and spray to wet leaves. One application should be sufficient; however, a repeat application may be required in 2 - 3 weeks for hard to control weeds.

Maximum Application Frequency: For good lawn management, normally two applications per year per treatment site are adequate. This does not include spot treatments.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. **Re-entry Interval:** Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treated areas until spray has thoroughly dried. **Protective Clothing:** Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks and shoes and chemical-resistant (e.g., rubber) gloves. **Operator Use Precautions:** Wash hands before eating, drinking, using tobacco or using the toilet.
