PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Do not inhale fumes. Avoid breathing spray mist.

PROTECTIVE CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT:

HANDLING THE CONCENTRATE (MIXING AND LOADING): wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, chemical-resistant gloves, socks and shoes, and protective eye wear (face shield or safety glasses). Rinse gloves before removal. Coveralls or a chemical-resistant apron should also be worn when open pouring from containers greater than 5 L. Do not wear contaminated shoes.

OPERATOR USE PRECAUTIONS:

- C Wear freshly laundered clothing and clean protective equipment daily.
- C Rinse gloves before removal.
- C Wash hands before eating, drinking, using tobacco or using the toilet.
- C If herbicide penetrates clothing, remove immediately; then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Throw away clothing and other absorbent materials that have been drenched or heavily contaminated with this product's concentrate.
- C After using the product, remove clothing and launder separately, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water. Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning personal protective equipment. If no such instructions for washables are provided, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash personal protective clothing and equipment separate from household laundry.
- C After work, remove all clothing and shower using soap and water.

FIRST AID: If swallowed, induce vomiting. Rush patient to nearest hospital or poison control centre taking this label with you. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. In case of skin contact, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. In case of eye contact, flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes and get medical attention **or contact a poison control**

centre. If inhaled, remove to fresh air and get medical attention **or contact a poison control centre.**

STORAGE: Store container tightly closed and away from seeds, feeds, fertilizer, plants and foodstuffs. Protect from freezing. Insecticides and fungicides should be segregated from herbicides so as to prevent the possibility of cross-contamination. **SHAKE OR MIX WELL BEFORE USING.**

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To be used only in the manufacture of herbicide which is registered under the PEST CONTROL PRODUCTS ACT. Read Technical Bulletin for formulation details.

USE PRECAUTIONS

TRANSFER SYSTEM:

FOR CONTAINERS LARGER THAN 20 L: Use a transfer system that avoids open pouring when transferring the liquid concentrate from such containers into other tanks.

Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not contaminate water used for irrigation or domestic purposes. Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides.

FOR SPILLS (use appropriate safety equipment): Absorb spill in inert material such as sand or sawdust. Dike area in case of large spills. Do not clean up with water.

RETURNABLE CONTAINERS

After use, return cleaned container to point of purchase or designated locations. Do not reuse container for any other purpose.

RETURNABLE-REFILLABLE CONTAINERS

After use, return the container to the point of purchase or designated locations. This container must only be refilled with MECO-D Manufacturing Concentrate. Do not reuse container for any other purpose. Prior to refilling inspect thoroughly for damage such as cracks, punctures, abrasions, and damaged or worn out threads on

closure devices. Check for leaks after refilling and before transportation. Do not refill or transport damaged or leaking containers. If the container is not being refilled, return to point of purchase.

DISPOSAL:

Canadian formulators of this technical should dispose of unwanted active and containers in accordance with municipal or provincial regulations. For additional details and clean up of spills contact the provincial regulatory agency or the manufacturer.

If involved in fire use water fog, foam, CO₂, dry chemical. If fighting fire use pressure demand self-contained air supply. Noxious fumes may be produced under fire conditions. Contain water from fire fighting to prevent entry to water supplies.
