DIRECTIONS: PLACE BAIT IN DRY CONTAINERS WHERE RODENTS TRAVEL OR FEED. PLACE BAITS IN PROTECTED AREAS INACCESSIBLE TO CHILDREN AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS OR IN TAMPER-RESISTANT BAIT BOXES. DO NOT CONTAMINATE FOOD OR FEED. FOR RATS, USE 200 TO 300 G, MICE 50 TO 100 G IN PILES TO ALL BURROWS OR HOLES ALONG WALLS. MAINTAIN CONTINUOUS SUPPLY UNTIL SIGNS OF FEEDING HAVE STOPPED. PERMANENT STATIONS SHOULD HAVE FRESH BAIT EVERY 2 WEEKS OR WHEN BAIT BECOMES STALE.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN, PETS, DOMESTIC ANIMALS AND WILDLIFE. DO NOT EXPOSE TREATED BAIT IN AREAS ACCESSIBLE TO CHILDREN, PETS, DOMESTIC ANIMALS AND WILDLIFE EXCEPT WHEN ENCLOSED WITHIN A TAMPER-RESISTANT BAIT BOX. KEEP AWAY FROM FEED OR FOOD STUFFS. DO NOT GET IN EYES, ON SKIN OR ON CLOTHING. WASH ARMS, HANDS AND FACE WITH SOAP AND WATER AFTER HANDLING AND BEFORE EATING OR SMOKING. KEEP OUT OF LAKES, STREAMS OR PONDS. IF SWALLOWED, THIS MATERIAL MAY CAUSE BLEEDING BY REDUCING THE CLOTTING ABILITY OF THE BLOOD.

FIRST AID: IF IN EYES, FLUSH WITH WATER FOR 15 MINUTES. IF ON SKIN, WASH WITH SOAP AND WATER. IF SWALLOWED, GIVE PATIENT ONE OR TWO GLASSES OF WATER AND INDUCE VOMITING BY TOUCHING THE BACK OF THE THROAT WITH A FINGER OR BLUNT OBJECT. REPEAT UNTIL VOMIT FLUID IS CLEAR. DO NOT GIVE ANYTHING BY MOUTH TO AN UNCONSCIOUS PERSON. CONTACT A PHYSICIAN OR POISON CONTROL CENTRE IMMEDIATELY.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION: VITAMIN K1 IN THE FORM OF INTRAVENOUS, INTRAMUSCULAR OR SUBCUTANEOUS INJECTIONS, OR BY ORAL INGESTION ARE SUGGESTED REMEDIAL TREATMENTS FOR ANTICOAGULANT POISONING. THE SEVERITY OF THE CASE MEASURED BY ESTABLISHING PROLONGED PROTHROMBIN TIMES(P.T.) WILL DETERMINE APPROPRIATE THERAPY. MONITORING P.T. WILL INDICATE THE NECESSITY OF REPEATED TREATMENTS.

DISPOSAL: DO NOT REUSE EMPTY CONTAINER. WRAP AND DISPOSE OF EMPTY CONTAINER IN HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE. DISPOSE OF UNUSED AND STALE BAIT IN ACCORDANCE WITH LOCAL REQUIREMENTS. DISPOSE OF DEAD RODENTS IN GARBAGE OR BY BURYING.
