DIRECTIONS: Tub and Tile Cleaner will clean, disinfect and deodorize non porous surfaces such as tubs, tiles, sinks, walls, countertops and all enamel and porcelain surfaces. For use in homes, cottages and mobile homes.

1. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.
2. TO CLEAN A SURFACE: Hold can 10-20 cm from surface to be cleaned: spray evenly to cover entire surface. Wipe off after 10-20 seconds with a clean cloth or sponge. For heavy build up allow product to penetrate for 1 minute then wipe clean.

TO DISINFECT NONPOROUS SURFACES: Clean surface as described above. Then cover entire surface with foam. Allow foam to wet surface completely; wait 10 minutes then wipe treated surface with a clean cloth or sponge. NOTE: All food surfaces such as work surfaces and processing appliances must be rinsed with potable water before re-use.

PRECAUTIONS: KEEP OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN. Use only on hard non porous surfaces. Avoid contamination of food in the application and storage of the product. For sensitive skin wear rubber gloves when wiping residue. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate. Do not place in hot water or near radiators, stoves or other sources of heat, or store at temperatures over 50EC. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Avoid inhalation of spray. Avoid contamination of food in the application and storage of the product.

FIRST AID: If splashed in eyes, flush with clean water for 15 minutes. If irritation persists, obtain medical attention. If swallowed, drink large quantities of milk or water. Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician at once. If on skin wash off with soap and water. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you, when seeking medical attention.

DISPOSAL: When container is empty, press button to release all pressure, then dispose in household garbage. Do not puncture or incinerate.

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
