DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS: In food processing plants apply only when plant is <u>not</u> in operation. Remove all food before treatment. Cover all food processing surfaces and thoroughly clean with potable water before resuming operation.

<u>FLYING INSECTS</u>: Use 100 mL per 100 cubic meters to kill flies, mosquitoes, gnats and exposed stages of grain moths. Using a spraying device or ULV equipment similar to Tri-Jet Fogger to dispense SUPER FOG as a fine mist, apply at a rate of 100 mL of spray per 100 $\rm m^3$ of room space. Remove all animals from

treatment area before using as a space spray. Close all doors and windows and shut off ventilating systems. Direct spray upwards to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources. Also direct mist into areas where insects are present. Spray only when temperature is below 32EC. Keep areas sealed for 30 minutes after each treatment. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate treated areas thoroughly for at least 30 minutes before re-entry. Ensure proper ventilation after sealed areas have been treated. Following ventilation, clean up dead insects.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Use 200 mL per 100 cubic meters to kill cockroaches, silverfish, and exposed stages of grain beetles. Using a spraying device or ULV equipment similar to Tri-Jet Fogger to dispense SUPER FOG as a fine mist, apply at a rate of 200 mL of spray per 100m3 of room space. Remove all animals from treatment area before using as a space spray. Close all doors and windows and shut off ventilating systems. Direct spray upwards to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources. Also direct mist into areas where insects are present, such as cracks and crevices, around baseboards and drain pipes. Spray only when temperature is below 32EC. Keep area sealed for 30 minutes after each treatment. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate treated areas thoroughly for at least 30 minutes before re-entry. Ensure proper ventilation after sealed areas have been treated. Following ventilation, clean up dead insects.

<u>PRECAUTIONS:</u> KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. READ MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET.

Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. Avoid inhalation of spray. Product contains Petroleum Distillate. store, pour or use near fire or flame. Wear mask or respirator when applying spray mist. Wear protective clothing, safety goggles, and chemically resistant gloves when using product. Harmful is swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after use. Do not contaminate feed, water or food stuffs. Any treated surface that may contact food or feed products should be washed thoroughly with potable water after spraying and before reuse. Do not use in milk processing plants or milk parlours. Do not use near birds, fish or pets. Do not spray on plastic or varnished surfaces. Do not spray closer than 1 m to fabric. (Exceeding dosage rates and biweekly applications may cause stains on fabrics, furs, and other materials). toxic to fish. Do not contaminate any body of water.

FIRST AID: If inhaled, remove victim to fresh air. If breathing has stopped, begin artificial respiration. Call physician immediately. For eye contact, flush with running water for at least 15 minutes. Call physician. For skin contact, wash with soap and water while removing contaminated clothing.
