DIRECTIONS:

Initial shock dosages of 50 to 100 ppm of DEARCIDE 709 are recommended to control bacterial slimes and algae encountered in open recirculating cooling water systems. After control is evident, shock dosages may be reduced to 20 to 50 ppm or applied less often.

CAUTION:

Keep out of reach of children. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Avoid breathing vapor or mist. Do not take internally. Wash thoroughly after handling. DO NOT USE IN POTABLE WATER.

FIRST AID:

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes and skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If inhaled, remove person immediately to fresh air. If not breathing, apply artificial respiration.
