- Insert (colour) plug at end of hose into (colour) spout on cap until it clicks.
- Flip up spout.

ILLUSTRATION #2]

- Point sprayer away from body.
- Grasp sprayer by the handle.
- SLOWLY pull ring at bottom of sprayer handle until it stops to ready the sprayer.

- Twist nozzle at end of sprayer to adjust spray pattern.

- Press button on sprayer to begin spraying and hold down for continuous spray.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

HOW TO APPLY

Follow illustrations and instructions above.

1. Twist nozzle at end of sprayer to open.
2. Point sprayer away from body and press sprayer button to begin spraying.
3. Pull ring at base of sprayer as needed to continue spraying.
4. Aim at centre of weed and spray to lightly cover.

WHEN TO APPLY

- Spray when weeds are young and actively growing.
- Spray when temperature is below 32°C (90°F).
- Some weeds may require up to 4 weeks for complete kill. Hard to kill weeds may require a repeat application in 3 to 4 weeks.
- Do not water for 48 hours. Rain within 6 hours after application reduces effectiveness.
- Spray acts within a few days and weeds gradually die. Grass fills in as weeds disappear.

IMPORTANT

- Do not use this product for controlling weeds in vegetable gardens, flower beds or around shrubs or ornamental plants.
- Avoid spraying desirable plants such as ornamentals, flowers, shrubs, vegetables and fruits crops; and avoid spray drift onto these susceptible plants.
- Do not apply to newly seeded lawns until after third mowing.
- Do not use on bent grass varieties (golf greens) and Bentgrass lawns.

CONTAINER USE AND STORAGE DIRECTIONS: [*icon & illustration*]

Follow illustrations and instructions above to ready the sprayer. Twist nozzle at end of sprayer to adjust spray pattern. Point sprayer at unwanted weeds or grasses and press sprayer button to begin spraying. Hold down for continuous spray. Pull ring at sprayer bottom again as needed for additional spraying. Completely dispense product in sprayer prior to storage. Twist sprayer nozzle to the OFF position. Flip down (colour) spout on cap. NO NEED TO DISCONNECT SPRAYER HOSE FROM CAP. Place sprayer back in side carrier on bottle with the nozzle facing down. Store this product in its original container in a secure area away from children and pets. Do not put into food or drink containers. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Store in a cool, dry place, preferably in a locked storage area. Protect container from freezing.

REUSE AND REFILL INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Refill **ONLY** with concentrated Killex® Lawn Weed Control following the directions in #3 below. Do not use this container for other products.
2. For refilling, remove the entire pumping mechanism. Prepare Killex concentrate carefully following refill instructions below:
3. **Killex Lawn Weed Control PCP# 9350**
 - a) Measure 30 mL (2 tbsp) of Killex concentrate into the empty container.
 - b) Add 5 litres (1 gallon) of clean water to container.
 - c) Follow "Application Directions".

Wrap and dispose partially used or empty container with household garbage. Do not reuse empty container except to refill in accordance with refill instructions.

PRECAUTIONS: [*icon*]

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful to some desirable plants. Avoid spraying flowers, shrubs, vegetable and fruit crops. Bent grass may be injured. Do not store near seeds, fertilizers, insecticides or fungicides. Keep from freezing. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Store in original container in a dry, secured storage area. Keep container tightly closed when not in use.

Protective Clothing:

- Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks and shoes.

Operator Use Precautions:

- Wash hands before eating, drinking, using tobacco or using the toilet.
- After treating, wash thoroughly.

- If pesticide penetrates clothing, remove immediately; then wash contaminated skin thoroughly and shower. Launder contaminated clothing separately before reuse.

Re-entry Interval for Turf:

- Do not allow people (other than the applicator) or pets on the treatment area during application.
- Do not enter treated areas until spray has thoroughly dried.

Maximum Application Frequency to Turf:

- For good turf/lawn management, normally two applications per year per treatment site are adequate. This does not include spot treatments.
