DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This product is to be used only by experienced personnel in the control of field rodents.

Treat at the rate of 7 kg of bait per acre, preferably during spring and/or fall. The bait may be broadcast over areas that are infested with harmful meadow voles (*Micritus pennsylvanicus*) and deer mice (*Perimyscus* sp).

PRECAUTIONS

Harmful if swallowed.

This product can be absorbed through skin, so it should be handled with gloves. Keep away from humans, domestic animals and pets.

This product is toxic to wildlife. The use of anticoagulant formulations can present a significant hazard to predatory mammals and birds through secondary poisoning.
